About the Asheville Professionals Chapter

We are a team of experienced professionals with backgrounds in environmental, manufacturing, chemical, civil, mechanical, and software engineering. We are passionate about helping people solve problems and improve their lives.

In 2015, our team of volunteer Asheville NC engineers saw children kicking a soccer ball into a medical waste burn pile in Uluthu Village Kenya. A year later, in collaboration with the community, we completed the build of a safe medical waste incinerator at the Uluthu Medical Hospital and Dispensary.

Our current project aims to improve medical waste disposal at the larger Siaya County Hospital near Uluthu. The hospital serves more than 300 people per day (106,800 people/year) providing all types of medical services including antimalarial and antiretroviral drugs, HIV testing, prenatal care and childbirth, as well as first aid and surgery.
